## Part D. Projection for Future Support Costs

As shown in the attached budget, our School Community Councils have traditionally supported technology supplies and materials with our Land Trust funds (\$188,000 in SY16-17 and \$151,780 in SY15-16). With the recent ballot initiative that allows additional funds to be distributed to schools, we anticipate Land Trust funds will continue to be utilized to expand and replace our computer labs and future i-pad needs at each campus

The school is committed to continued use of Alma through the use of state wpu funds if other resources are not available.

Our district will work collectively with our business administrator to monitor the costs associated with digital teaching and learning. As cost savings are realized (through textbook savings, transitioning devices from students to classrooms as part of recycle, etc.) we are committed to repurposing those funds to support the refresh needs associated with infrastructure necessary to sustain and grow digital teaching and learning. We will look to grow beyond our goal set to address additional subject areas and grade levels as funds become realized.
