Draper 2 campus made significant progress on SY22 goals. One highlight is for 1st grade Acadience Reading composite scores, 45% of "well below" students moved above that category. Also, Draper 2 met the goal of offering more used uniforms to parents at an affordable price. One goal that is still in progress is to improve parent involvement throughout the school. Draper 2 has created specific targets and action items to reach this goal during the 2022-2023 school year.
